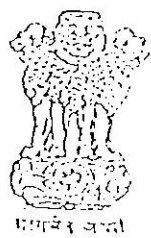

S.R.O. 510.—The following Order made by the President is published for general information:—

THE CONSTITUTION (SCHEDULED TRIBES) ORDER, 1950

22. In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 342 of the Constitution of India the President, after consultation with the Governors and Rajpramukhs of the States concerned, is pleased to make the following Order, nameiy:—

1. This Order may be called the Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) Order, 1950.

2. The tribes or tribal communities, or parts of, or groups within, tribes or tribal communities, specified in Parts I to XIV of the Schedule to this Order shall, in relation to the States to which those Parts respectively relate, be deemed to be Scheduled Tribes so far as regards members thereof resident in the localities specified in relation to them respectively in those Parts of that Schedule.

3. Any reference in the Schedule to this Order to a district or other territorial division of a State shall be construed as a reference to that district or other territorial division as existing on the 26th January, 1950.

THE CONSTITUTION (SCHEDULED TRIBES) (PART C STATES) ORDER, 1951

C. O. 33.—In exercise of the powers conferred by clause (1) of Article 342 of the Constitution of India, as amended by the Constitution (First Amendment) Act, 1951, the President is pleased to make the following Order, namely:—

in Parts I to VIII of the Schedule to this Order shall, in relation to the States to which those Parts respectively relate, be deemed to be Scheduled Tribes so far as regards members thereof residing in the localities specified in relation to them respectively in those Parts of that Schedule

1. This Order may be called the Constitution (Scheduled Tribes) (Part C States) Order, 1951.

3. Any reference in the Schedule to this Order to a district or other territorial division of a State shall be construed as a reference to that division or other territorial division of a State as it exists on the 1st day of January 1951.
